Topic: Expressing preference, making comparisons.

Level: Elementary and pre-intermediate

Aims:

- to develop the ability to make comparisons
- to develop reading skills
- to expand students knowledge about Ireland
- to practice speaking skills, expressing preferences
- to practice writing skills
- to develop the ability to deduce meaning from context

Language practised:

vocabulary: words connected with tourism, entertainment and recreation

grammar structures: comparison of adjectives
 comparison with more than, less than
 intensifier much + comparative adjective
 comparison with (not) asas

communication: making comparison, expressing preference

Time allocated: 90- 120 minutes

Aids: prepared worksheets, computers with an access to the internet

Anticipated problems

- Frequently asked questions about meaning of new words

Procedure:

I. Pre- computer work:
